2021 CONTEST CALENDAR

You may have seen the BMFA notice that we will not have the use of Barkston Heath for competitions this year. For that reason the Free Flight Nationals and the Radio power Nationals at the end of August have had to be cancelled. However, the FFTC are looking at options to run a very pared down Nationals later in the year. We will update you all when any decisions have been made.

We have clearance to fly at Sculthorpe, North Luffenham and Salisbury Plain enabling the contest calendar to recommence from the third Area event on April 25. The Plugge Cup and Senior Championships will be run this year.

The following calendar is published on the understanding that Covid restrictions will enable competitions to take place. If any events are cancelled due to Covid restrictions they will be cancelled ahead of the event date via the FFTC website with as much notice as possible.

THE LONDON GALA

A decision has been made to move the London Gala from the 8 – 9 May until the 29 – 30^{th} May. That weekend has been freed up due to the Nationals being cancelled. The main reason however for this move is that it is after the covid restrictions are lifted on 17^{th} May allowing overnight stays in hotels to be permissible. The Club Championships will be held on the Saturday classes.

TEAM SELECTION F1A/B/C

At this time it has still not been certain if the 2021 World Championships in France will go ahead in August, the final decision is due in May. If it goes ahead the team selection will take place on 12/13 June as per the calendar, with the fall back date being either the 19 or 20 June for the deciding flight, if needed. If the World Championships is cancelled we have decided to use the 12/13 June weekend for the first trials weekend for the 2022 European Championships instead. In that circumstance the fall back weekend will be held at a date to be decided in the autumn, not the 19 or 20th June. If you have entered the team selection for the 2021 World Championships and the event is cancelled your entry will automatically be forwarded to the Team Selection for the 2022 European Championships. CAA REGULATIONS

FF & The new regulations for model flying

Reminders to renew your registration are being sent out by the CAA at present. If you have done the competency test last year through the BMFA and have paid your £9.00 fee for 2021 with your membership renewal please ignore the CAA request. You will shortly be sent a new ID number.

A reminder - Flyers of models of less than 250 grams are exempt from having to have evidence of competency or have CAA registration for general flying. However, there is now a subtle change in the regulations which needs consideration. If you want to take advantage of the BMFA's CAA Authorisation (which unlocks permission to fly above 400ft – and a decent thermal will ensure that this happens) you are now required from the 1st January 2021 to take the BMFA's online test, register with the CAA (which you can do via the BMFA) and display your CAA number on your models. The CAA has also re-iterated that free flight models must not be deliberately flown beyond visual line of sight.

If you are a free flight competition flyer you will need to register as your models will at times breach 400ft, even it is only a very small light model.

CLASSIC A1 GLIDER 'POSTAL' CONTEST

This is not an FFTC run competition but it has raised a lot of interest around the World so we have agreed to put this notice in the newsletter. Stuart has now extended the closing date to make flights until the end of the year. Over to Stuart –

Most of you will be aware that Stuart Darmon is running an 'Email international' contest for Classic A1 gliders, sponsored by FF 'cottage industries', partly to keep the ball rolling for this 'new' and popular informal class, but mostly to give us all something to do while we wait for 'normal' contests to get going again. However, not everyone reads the modelling press, so for the benefit of those who still aren't sure of the rules, here they are:

CLASSIC A1 GLIDER EMAIL INTERNATIONAL 2021

1. ELIGIBLE MODELS

A Classic A1 glider is any Free Flight towline glider of total projected surface area not exceeding 18 square decimetres, built in accordance with a design first published or kitted between January 1951 and January 1961, as per BMFA Classic Glider rules (https://britishmfa.sharepoint.com/sites/public/Rule Books)

Maximum length of towline 50 metres under 2Kg. tensile load

2. THE CONTEST

All flights for each entry must be made on the same day between 01 January 2021 and December 31 2021 inclusive. All flights must comply with local regulations governing model flying and with the guidelines of the national aeromodelling governing body (BMFA, AMA, etc.)

All flights for each entry must be made with the same model. An individual may make up to three separate entries provided that each is made with an entirely different eligible model.

A model may not be used by more than one individual over the age of 16 years. Juniors below this age may fly a model borrowed from another entrant.

The maximum for the first flight of each entry is 30 seconds. If this is achieved, the entrant is permitted a second flight of maximum 60 seconds, and so on, the maximum increasing in increments of 30 seconds until either a max is not achieved ,or flying cannot continue (e.g. because the model is lost or damaged). The score for that entry is the total flight time including the sub- max final flight.

All flights must be timed by a person other than the entrant. Procedure for starts, timing, attempts etc. is per F1H **except** that a flight aborted by RDT does **not** qualify for a second attempt, even if less than 20 seconds (in line with BMFA classic rules)

3. <u>ENTRY</u>

Entry is free of charge. Once the flights are completed, entry is submitted no later than 31 December 2021 by email to <u>classica1postal@gmail.com</u> by sending the following information;

- 1.) The name & contact email* of the entrant
- 2.) The name(s) of the timekeeper(s)
- 3.) The score, in seconds, in the form of an addition, e.g.
- 30+ 60+ 90+ 120+ 124= 424
- 4.) The name of the model and where it was published
- 5.) The country and location where the flights were made

If entrants aged 16 or under wish to be eligible for the junior prize they must include their age in years (D.O.B. not required). Juniors are also included in the overall results and are eligible for the other prizes.

In order to qualify for the team prize the entries of all three team members must be submitted in the same email, also stating the name of the team. Entries received in this way will also be included in the individual results.

Information about the flying, the site, etc. plus photographs will be very welcome and will help in reporting the contest in the modelling press.

Winner receives a trophy plus a complete Peter Brown stand- alone RDT system; second wins a £50 Free Flight supplies voucher and 3rd a subscription to Aeromodeller. Top junior gets a Hummingbird Models laser cut A1 kit and the team of three with highest aggregate score each get an engraved whisky tumbler trophy. To encourage people to send in scores, there's a prize draw of non-winning entries to win ten rolled sheets of coloured Esaki tissue. Entry is free.
