# **2024 CONTEST ENTRY FEES**

Single Entry Fees £5 (Covers all events on any single day at Area or Centralised Contests and all F1E contests). Multi day contests £5 per day.

Separate site fee is applicable. Site fee on FFTC sites is £5 per day; non FFTC sites charge may vary.

Team Selection: £30 covers all classes and site fee (included is Season Ticket).

World Cup: £30 per event (included is Season Ticket).

Note: Members of clubs who have use of the site for trimming and practise, i.e Grantham Club members for Barkston Heath, or permit holders for Salisbury Plain or North Luffenham, will still need to pay the field charge if they enter a contest.

Juniors: Free of Charge and no site fee except for Nationals

Nats Entry Fees – £10.00 a day plus site fee. £25 to cover all three days.

Space: Single Entry Fees £0 - but pay relevant Field charge for site

### **2024 SEASON TICKET**

The Season Ticket for 2024 has been set at £75. It represents excellent value covering entry to all FFTC run events apart from the Area event site fees and the Nationals. Season tickets for 2023 are available now from John Carter. Please allow 14 days turn around for the licence to be operative.

## FREE FLIGHT RULES 2024 UPDATE

Throughout the year we have received numerous requests for rule changes, correction of errors across disciplines as well as areas where sometimes clarity is required. The committee has considered each, and we have agreed that the following rule changes will come into effect in 2024.

<u>Please note</u> this is a summary and we would strongly advocate that all competitors check the 2024 Rulebook ahead of the contest as more detail is within the book.

- All references to the Competition Secretary have been removed and replaced with The Sporting Director.
- Clarification of the ownership of models
- Clarification of 5-minute flyoff window for BMFA Area Contests
- Light emitting beacons may be used in all classes.
- F1Q UK added to Combined Electric
- Combined Electric Half motor runs in flyoff.
- All Free Flight Contests should start at 10am. (note Team selection falls outside of this directive, and will be agreed in advance dependent on the venues local rules)
- F1Q added throughout rule book for events and Team Selection
- Senior Team selection all classes now have a minimum performance standard of 70% of the winners 'rounds' duration applied to qualify for a Team Place.

- Team selection go/no-go announcement to be made 48 hours in advance.
- Team selection one off flyoff clarification
- Class F1S (E36) motor run reduced to 7 seconds to accord with others worldwide.

We anticipate the 2024 Edition of the Rule Book to be available anytime and will ensure as soon as it is available you are notified on how to obtain it.

If you wish the FFTC to consider future amendments, rule changes etc. please do send these to the FFTC Secretary the earlier the better in order that these can be reviewed well ahead of the deadline for rule changes in October 2024.
