Venue

All three days to be at Sculthorpe, North Norfolk.

Facilities and access

- There will be no camping or overnight stay allowed on the airfield. There will be no facilities except for the provision of toilets.
- No dogs under any circumstance are allowed on the field.
- All attendees must be BMFA members and must have their membership card with them. Family members are permitted access.

Payments

- There is a no pre-entry requirement. Pay on entry on the day, cash only. The fee will be a simple £10.00 per day charge. This fee allows the entrant to fly in as many events as they desire. BMFA season ticket holders will be required to pay the entry fee.
- A discounted payment of £25.00 will cover all three days.
- The fee covers entry into all free flight, space, Bowden and scale events.
- Casual sport flyers will be required to pay the same entry fees.

Flying Site

The flying site is situated to the North of the A148 between Fakenham and King's Lynn, just East of the B1454 to Docking and Hunstanton, it will be signposted. GPS coordinates for the site entrance are 52°50'12.73"N, 0°44'44.7"E (decimal 52.83687, 0.74575).

The terrain is mostly short grass, with a mixture of paved runway and perimeter track - Contestants must not drive or park on the runways at any time. The land is a military training area, which is carefully managed to preserve the infrastructure and wildlife. Strictly no dogs are permitted on site, even within cars. Model retrieval is on bicycle or foot. The area must be kept clean and tidy at all times and rules to protect the site must be observed. Please note-there are no catering facilities available - competitors must bring their own food and drink.

Programme

Events will start at 09.00. There will be 5 rounds plus fly-offs flown from a flight line. The Max for round 1 will be 240 seconds. All other rounds will be 180 seconds Max. These maximum times and program may vary according to circumstances.

Rules

The relevant section of the FAI Sporting Code will be followed. All competitors must hold a valid FAI licence and FAI ID number. F1Q will be flown to the 2 Joules / 20 seconds rule.


