SITE LIMITATIONS

Some of the sites we use for contests can be restrictive in size. Inevitably there will be occasions beyond our control that the max will have to be reduced, or the event will have to be cancelled due to these restrictions. This is particularly noticeable at North Luffenham, a site that is less suitable for flying contests when the wind is strong. Unfortunately, we have little alternative these days but to consider a short notice alteration to the contest. As always the CD will have the final say on the day or before if it obvious that the conditions will be unsuitable.
