The FFTC met at the Leicester office on 27 March 2017.

CLASHES AND CHANGES

The FFTC receive communications from the free flight community and endeavour to reply to all. We do consider all input regarding what is happening. Not everyone will be happy with all the decisions that are made, but rest assured that we try to do what we think is best for the overall health of free flight.

Some cases in point:

Clashes of contest dates with other events. We try to spread the calendar across the year as best as possible. Centralised events can be and are dictated by site availability and even then, there may well be restrictions that are beyond our control. The area events are spread across the year and as such there will no doubt be problems, if we avoided all possibility of clashes many days would have to be excluded to chagrin of those who had no interest or involvement in that particular special day.

Nationals classes:

Whatever we do regarding the schedule it will not suit all. The pattern that has evolved seems to cause least number of issues. The idea of circulating the days every year has been suggested however such a move would upset those who like the current schedule and could cause, for example, all sorts of issues like recovery of models from fly offs of the open classes if flown late on the Monday. We will continue to monitor and listen views. We will act on what is feasible and that which we consider will improve the event.

Rules:

The shortened period for fly offs has caused some concern. Why was it done? The fly off is the last shot and should have a degree of pressure and by cutting the period there is a possibility that there will be a reduced chance of lift. Plus this creates a no mistakes scenario! Please note CIAM are proposing a similar idea of reducing the fly off period for the same reasons.

Feed-back:

Please allow plenty of time for your ideas to get into the system. Remember that there is a rule process and we are already having to consider next year's plans and ideas. Nationals plans must be in place by January in order to sort publicity, printing, medals etc.

JUNIOR TEAM FOR 2017 EURO CHAMPS

Juniors that wish to be considered for a place on the team for the 2017 European Championships will be selected on their performance in the respective classes at the Nationals.

JUNIOR TEAM FOR FUTURE CHAMPIONSHIPS

For the Junior World and European teams for F1A, F1B and F1P, team selection will be based on the strength of the competitor's performance in BMFA contests and/or in UK hosted FF World Cup contests during the year immediately prior to that in which the World or European Championship will be held. Only Juniors will be permitted to fly F1P class models in the F1C class. Juniors must be a minimum of 12 years of age on 1st January of the year in which the team will compete.

In order to provide practice opportunities for UK Junior power team members, only juniors may compete with F1P models flying to the same maximum as F1C and with motor runs as FAI class definitions for F1P. All F1A, F1B, F1C and F1P Team Selection meetings shall be run, where relevant and desirable, as closely as possible to the FAI rules.




PRIZES AT CENTRALISED EVENTS

Flying Site

The site is situated to the south of the B390 between Shrewton and Chitterne and will be signposted from the B390.

The terrain is undulating rough grassland crossed by dirt roads and tracks. The land is a military training area, which is carefully managed to preserve the history and wildlife. Model retrieval is usually on foot.

The area must be kept clean and tidy at all times and rules to protect the site must be observed.

Please note-there are no catering facilities available - competitors must bring their own food and drink.

Programme

Events will start at 09.00. There will be 5 rounds plus fly-offs flown from a flight line. The Max for round 1 will be 240 seconds. All other rounds will be 180 seconds Max. These maximum times and program may vary according to circumstances. All competitors will receive a gift.

Rules

The relevant section of the FAI Sporting Code will be followed.

All competitors must hold a valid FAI licence.




