CONTEST RULES

A couple of rule suggestions were put to the Technical Committee when we met last week. Each was discussed in detail and whilst both do appear on the face of it to be sensible. The battery proposal was unanimously supported.

Further it was unanimously agreed that before making a final decision on the Electric Fly-off Proposal we would seek the Free Flight Communities comments before deciding (Proposal A below). The Electric classes are becoming ever more popular and as Rules Officer I would not wish to change this. Therefore I would like to invite comments on the following draft suggestion. Suggested Rule Changes – Electric Classes

Proposal A (Fly-Offs):

To reduce fly-off motor runs in other Electric classes as per E36 and F1S Electric classes.

Reasons:

Current fly-offs in all free flight classes very often give problems with out-flying available sites; this practice is becoming unacceptable. For Electric classes this problem can to a great extent be mitigated by reducing motor runs. In addition this reduction would provide a 'model' for future use in I.C. Power classes.

In F1Q and F1S Electric (International events) as well as UK E36 Electric classes this reduction is already the practice and can be seen to work well.

Details:

Rule: **3.3.5 F1Q (UK) Electric** – Delete Paragraph (b) and remove "heading (a)" from Paragraph (a).

Rule: 3.4.4 BMFA Electric – Change Paragraph (b) to:

Motor run, maximum time from launch:

For Brushed motors (no functions)	15 Seconds, fly-offs 8 seconds
For Brushed motors (with functions)	12 Seconds, fly-offs 6 seconds
For Brushless motors (no functions)	12 Seconds, fly-offs 6 seconds
For Brushless motors (with functions)	10 Seconds, fly-offs 5 seconds

Rule: 3.5.11 E36 Electric – Change final sentence in Paragraph (b) to read:

When E36 models are flown in Combined Electric contests the motor run will be 15 seconds, and 8 seconds for fly-offs.

Rule: 3.13 E30 Electric – Change final sentence to read:

The maximum motor run from launch of the model shall be 60 seconds, and 30 seconds for fly-offs.

Agreed Rule Change

Rule: Class 3.13 E30 Electric.

The current rule regarding batteries is as follows.....Maximum battery size3 x 50 mAh Nickel based cellsor1 x 70 mAh Lithium based cell

Reasons:

It is now very difficult to find suitable lipo's that are designated 70mAh. The batteries which I have used for several years (obtained from `Componentshop') are now marked 75mAh even though they are the same size and shape and as far as I can tell from testing are the same cells. The only cells available that are marked 70mAh are the `E-Flite' ones which for the most part are not good enough.

Details:

Rule change to read as follows...

Maximum battery size3 x 50 mAh Nickel based cells

..... 1 x 75 mAh Lithium based cell or

Mike Woodhouse has received the following notice from DTE Landmarc:-



Flying Site

The site is situated to the south of the B390 between Shrewton and Chitterne and will be signposted from the B390. GPS coordinates for the site entrance are 51°11'29.53"N, 1°57'32.59"W.

The terrain is undulating rough grassland crossed by dirt roads and tracks. The land is a military training area, which is carefully managed to preserve the history and wildlife. Model retrieval is usually on foot.

The area must be kept clean and tidy at all times and rules to protect the site must be observed.

Please note-there are no catering facilities available - competitors must bring their own food and drink.

Programme

Events will start at 09.00. There will be 5 rounds plus fly-offs flown from a flight line. The Max for round 1 will be 240 seconds. All other rounds will be 180 seconds Max. These maximum times and program may vary according to circumstances. All competitors will receive a gift.

Rules

The relevant section of the FAI Sporting Code will be followed.

All competitors must hold a valid FAI licence and FAI ID number.


